For BEd(ECE) and HD(ECE) programmes

EdUHK is one of the teacher education providers in Hong Kong. Graduates of the University's teacher education programmes are eligible to apply to become fully qualified and registered teachers. As regards teacher registration, graduates should approach the Teacher Registration Team of the Education Bureau (EDB) to submit applications directly. All applications will be assessed by the EDB which will consider, among other things, whether an applicant has been convicted of any criminal offence (including sex-related offences) in Hong Kong or elsewhere, or is involved in any ongoing criminal proceedings or investigations. For details, please browse the EDB's website.

Important Note: The University will ask students of our full-time teacher education programmes to declare whether they have been convicted of or are being prosecuted for any sex-related offence in Hong Kong or elsewhere, and to provide relevant details prior to undertaking teaching practice. Such information may be released to their placement schools. The University reserves the right not to allow these students to attend the block teaching practice. If so, they won't be able to meet the graduation requirements of the programmes.

Students admitted into this programme are required to visit the Greater Bay Area (GBA) and/or other parts of Mainland China. Programme may also require students to participate in other non-local learning experience for completion of the programme. While the visits are heavily subsidised, students are still required to contribute part of the estimated cost of the visits ("student contribution"), whereas personal entertainment, meals expenses, travel document fee and personal insurance costs will not be supported. The estimated cost of the visits for students admitted to the 2024/25 cohort is not available yet as it is subject to a variety of factors such as changes to the cost of the visits as a result of inflation, trip duration, traveling expenses, the exchange rate, etc. The exact amount of student contribution is thus not available.

General Admission Requirements

- ◆ The programme accepts applicants who fulfil the following entrance requirements:
 - Applicants holding a recognised post-secondary qualification, such as an Associate Degree / Higher Diploma, preferably in early childhood studies or a related discipline; or
 - Transfer students who have completed at least two years of study of a 4-year full-time degree programme in a recognised institution, preferably in early childhood studies or a related discipline; or
 - Mature applicants (aged 25 or above on 31 August of the year in which applicants commence their studies) who have specific talents, achievements, or a wealth of relevant experience; or
 - Other equivalent qualifications to be assessed on an individual basis
- ◆ Final-year students of recognised local Associate Degree / Higher Diploma programmes can also apply. Selected applicants are required to successfully complete the relevant Associate Degree / Higher Diploma programmes with a good GPA
- ◆ In addition, applicants must demonstrate an acceptable level of proficiency in English language, unless exempted by the University. Priority will be given to applicants who have obtained Level 3 in HKDSE English Language or equivalent⁺
- ◆ Applicants are also required to have satisfactory performance in the admission interview and / or test

⁺ The following public examination results are recognised as equivalent to Level 3 of HKDSE English Language:

- A TOEFL score of 550 (paper-based) or 80 (Internet-based) or above; or
- A score of 6 or above in International English Language Testing System (IELTS), Academic Level; or
- Grade C or above in GCE O-Level / IGCSE English; or
- Grade C or above in GCSE English or English Literature; or
- Grade E or above in GCE AS Level or AL Level English; or
- Grade E or above in ASL Use of English in HKALE; or
- A score of 110 or above in JEE English Language
